Report on CTI gift bags for single male asylum seekers in Bradford December 2021

In December, CTI was asked by BIASAN (Bradford Immigration and Asylum Support and Advice Network) if it could provide Christmas gifts for the influx of single male asylum seekers recently arrived in Bradford. We set out to provide 225 gift bags and received enough for a total of 300 bags. This was a tremendous response from CTI members. There was enough left over from providing gifts to those in hotels to contribute substantially to BIASAN gifts for men in converted apartments and other housing in Bradford (500+ gift bags altogether, plus donations to BIASAN's women's group and family food bank). BIASAN said: "All the gentlemen send huge thanks and Christmas greetings. The joy was palpable. One chap said that before this he 'felt like a forgotten person' but now he knows that people remember people in his situation. Thank you again!"
